Introduction

- Life is not measured by the number of breaths we take, but by the moments that take our breath away.
- There is nothing like the experience to sit around a campfire under the African sky, far from the hassle and buss of the city. The further you can get from "civilization" the better.

Purpose of the Safari tour

- Afford members, family and friends an opportunity to travel and explore areas which are not easy or advisable to visit on their own.
- To travel in convoy on roads which are safe and accessible with a high clearance vehicle at times.
- Explore the Richtersveld (NWC) and western coast on Namibia.
- Visit places of interest which one may never be able to do in your lifetime.

Logistics

- Intended departure date 21 June 2013, for approximately 15 days, returning about 6 July 2013.
- Travel parties could join or depart the rest of the travel group at any stage (do not have to travel the entire journey).
- Proposed itinerary is just a framework which is open for suggestions and may be altered as we proceed.
- Parties visiting the Richtersveld need to indicate ASAP as reservation fees will be required very soon, first week in August 2012.





Day 1 – Friday 21 June 2013

- Cape Town – Lekkering via Springbok.
- Possibly camping to be arranged through local contacts.
- Estimated distance 720 km.

Day 2 – Saturday 22 June 2013

- Proceed to Sendelingsdrift (entry to RNP) to De Hoop campsite
- We'll camp here for two nights
- Travel distance 195 km
- Places of interest include The Wonderhole,
- Cost 6 p/sharing = R67 + park fee (wild card)

Day 3 – Sunday 23 June 2013

- Day travel in the RNP to Kokerboomkloof via Richtersberg via optional 4x4 route along the Orange River and back to De Hoop.
- Exploring the natural wonders and bushmen art.
- Places of interest may include the hand of God, Springbokvlakte, etc.
- Travel distance 132km

Day 4 – Monday 24 June 2013

- Exit RNP to Sendelingsdrift (border post) crossing Orange River via ferry moving on to Sesriem. Stay over for two nights.
- Estimated distance 413km
- Passports, road fee, ferry cost, etc.
- Waiting time as only two vehicles can cross at a time.
- Accommodation at Sesriem
- Cost

Day 5 - Tuesday 25 June 2013

- Explore Sesriem vicinity
- Trip to Sossusvlei and back
-120km return (4x4)
- Places of interest are: Sesriem canyon, Sossusvlei , Dune 45, Air ballooning, etc

Day 6 – Wednesday 26 June 2013

- Head north possibly to Hentiesbaai via Walvis Bay and Swakopmond.
- Estimated distance 395km
- Places of interest could include 4x4 options, visiting historical buildings, dune drives, etc
- Accommodation

Day 7 – Thursday 27 June 2013

- Destination – Khorixas – 384km
- Information
- Tarrifs
- Accommodation Aba-Huab camp
- Places of interest include Petrified forest, Organ pipes, Twyfelfontein, etc

Day 8 – Friday 28 June 2013

- Destination – Okaukuejo (Etosha) via Kamanjab 303km
- Activities include gaming, gaming and more game driving
- Tariffs calculate to R200 site fee & R100 p/p max 8 p/site $R1000/8 = R125$
- Other tariffs

Day 9 – Saturday 29 June 2013

- Halali Etosha
- Travel 90 Km
- What to do? 1, 2, 3, 4, 5

Day 10 – Sunday 30 June 2012

- Destination – Okahandja via Tsumeb – 594km
- Gross Barmen
- Places of interest include Tsumeb mines,

Day 11 – Monday 1 July 2013

- Destination – Windhoek
180km – via Windhoek
- Attraction dinosaurs pass,
Daan Viljoen
- Overnight TBA

Day 12 – Tuesday 2 July 2013

- Canon road house – 475 km
- At the roadhouse.

Day 13 - Wednesday 3 July 2013

- Destination - Ai-Ais 120km
- More
- Tariffs

Day 14 - Thursday 4 July 2013

- Destination Oeverbos along the Orange river RSA side via Noordoewer border post
- Travel distance 145km

Day 15 – Friday 5 July 2013

- Explore route to Helskloof area and return to Oewerbos, 65 km
- Relax and unwind along the Orange River
- Refresh before the final leg homeward bound.

Day 16 – Saturday 6 July 2013

- 670km home sweet home!
- Total distance – approx 5500km
- Estimated cost p/couple travelling alone without any towing vehicle or abnormal weight @ current fuel cost – 11-14 l/100km = approx **R7000** max (Fuel calculator)
- Accommodation @ ave **R125** p/n/p/couple for 15 nights = approx **R1875** p/p (**2=R3750**) or (**4=R7500**)
- Hence travel + accom Totals **R3700.00** p/p
- **Excluding food & beverages**
